### **INFORMATION**

The Belgian (Dutch Speaking) PEN Centre (<a href="www.penvlaanderen.be">www.penvlaanderen.be</a>) and Passa Porta House of Literature (<a href="www.passaporta.be">www.passaporta.be</a>) will be hosting this meeting, which this year will be held jointly with the International Cities of Refuge Network (ICORN) and Halma, a network of literary centres in Europe (<a href="www.halma-network.eu">www.halma-network.eu</a>).

## The Practicalities

#### **Invitations**

All Chairs of PEN Centre WiPCs are invited. If the Chair is not able to attend, your Centre may send another delegate. There is no limit to the number of additional delegates that the Centre may wish to send. Some Centres that do not have WiPCs but whose input we feel will be valuable have been invited.

### **Venue**

We will be holding our meetings at the KVS theatre in Central Brussels, who have kindly donated their premises free of charge as part of the Passa porta Festival <a href="https://www.kvs.be">www.kvs.be</a>

### **Registration Fees**

This conference is funded mainly by the registration fees paid by delegates to cover the costs of meeting room and equipment hire, meals and refreshments, local travel and administration. Participants are expected to cover their own travel and hotel costs. Prompt payment of fees would be most appreciated.

#### Airport/Eurostar/Train Transfer

Brussels airport is close to the city with easy transport by train shuttle to Brussel Centraal/Bruxelles Central railway station (nearest to Hotel Plaza and Hotel Ibis) as well as Brussel Noord/Bruxelles Nord (nearest to Max Hotel). The Conference venue KVS Theatre is halfway between both railway stations. Eurostar and Thalys trains arrive at Brussel Zuid/Bruxelles Midi - here you can connect to both other stations.
